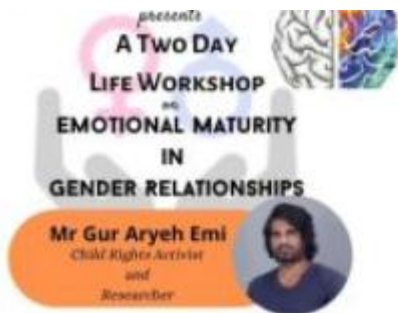
Awareness seminar on safe and happy periods- 30th August, 2022

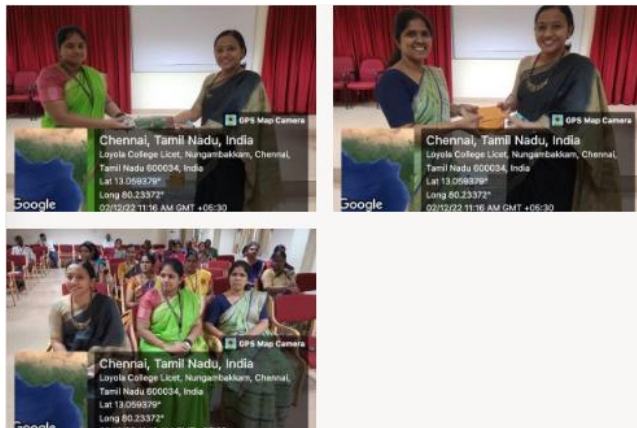
Seminar on international day of elimination of violence against women- 25th November, 2022
